

# Copyright Release Agreement

The National Art Education Association (hereinafter referred to as "NAEA") is pleased to undertake the publication of your contribution to its journal, *Art Education*, tentatively entitled:

(hereinafter referred to as "the Work").

NAEA, a nonprofit Virginia corporation with a business address at 1916 Association Drive, Reston, VA 20191-1590, asks you (hereinafter referred to as "Author") to assign the copyright, thus granting us all rights for the Work, so that you as author and we as publisher of the journal may be protected from the consequences of unauthorized use.

**COPYRIGHT ASSIGNMENT:** Whereas NAEA is undertaking to publish the Work in its journal, named above, and whereas you desire to have the Work so published, now therefore you grant and assign the entire copyright for the Work to NAEA for its exclusive use. The copyright consists of any and all rights of whatever kind or nature now or hereafter protected by the copyright laws of the United States and of all foreign countries, in all languages and forms of communication, and NAEA shall be the sole proprietor thereof. NAEA, in turn, grants you the right to reprint the Work in any book of which you are the author or editor, subject to your giving proper credit in the book to the original publication of the Work in the Journal. To protect the copyright notice as it appears in the Journal should be included in the credit.

In consideration for the Author's assignment to NAEA, NAEA plans to publish the Work in *Art Education*, a journal owned and published by NAEA. However, NAEA, in its sole discretion, reserves the right to reject the whole or any part of the Work and to demand that such revisions, additions, or other changes be made to render the Work acceptable to NAEA. Further, NAEA reserves the right to reject any Work that it decides is not up to the standards which it desires in works to be published by it.

**WARRANTY:** You warrant that the Work is original with you and that you have the full power to make this Agreement and grant, and that it in no way infringes upon any copyright or proprietary right of others. In the event that said Work and/or copyright thereto has been previously sold or otherwise transferred, for publication or otherwise, NAEA shall have the right, without limiting any other rights NAEA may have under federal and state law to (1) terminate this agreement immediately, or (2) have you obtain, at your own expense, any required consents or releases of any other publisher or person owning the rights of copyright thereto.

This agreement shall be constructed and interpreted according to the laws of Virginia, and shall be binding on the parties thereafter, their heirs, successors, assignees, and personal representatives.
